

An overview of our facilities . . .

STROUDSMOOR ... Is an Inn atop its own 350-acre mountain; A conference center conveniently accessible from several major highways and airports; an enchanting reception site replete with panoramic views, old-world charm and elegance, and finally STROUDSMOOR is a perfect weekend getaway or trattoria for intimate dining located in the majestic Pocono Mountains.

The original inn, called Highland Dell, was built in approximately 1840. A second lodge, which currently houses the Reservation Desk, dining room and public lounge, was added around the turn-of-the-century. In the late 30's the Inn received a new name, Stroudsmoor, along with the addition of cabins and cottages as more and more families began to visit. During the years that followed, various other buildings on the property have been lovingly restored to accommodate guests. Cedar House, now a three-bedroom suite, was once the caretaker's cottage. And, the Carriage House now houses the inn's Spa and Bridal Studio. Ledgemere Suites – 750 to 100 sq. ft. of luxury – were added to accommodate the needs of our Brides and Grooms on their wedding day.

SCI – The Restaurant at Stroudsmoor Country Inn – endeavors to provide an environment conducive to enjoying sophisticated dining featuring Classic cuisine and Inspired signature recipes in a setting rich in history and beauty.

Our mission is to assist in making memories, celebrating friendships and fostering romance; to afford our guests a staff unequaled in their ability to serve in a proficient and friendly manner, and, as in all our endeavors, to continue the Stroudsmoor traditions of impeccable quality and gracious hospitality in an atmosphere of old-world charm and elegance.

Stroudsmoor also offers five dedicated event facilities, each creating a unique atmosphere to host private gathering for both business and pleasure. A brief description of the Stroudsmoor Event Facilities follows:

Auradell

Auradell hosts the Inn's most intimate wedding celebrations and social events. Built in 1842, Auradell features guest suites on its second and third floors, each refurbished to include master bedrooms and living areas that look out over Stroudsmoor proper. The Auradell Grotto is nestled in a wooded area overlooking the town of Stroudsburg – its wisteria-covered arbor delivers guests into the grotto and shelters the Bride's arrival. The first floor at Auradell offers a solarium and hearthside suite for the cocktail hour, while The Gallery at Stroudsmoor, featuring the works of renowned regional artists, hosts the reception at Auradell. Finally, the ground level – once the manor's grand ballroom – houses a bridal registry for every wedding day accoutrement imaginable and the Stroudsmoor Floral and Décor Studios.

The Stone Room

An intimate private dining room located in Stroudsmoor's Historic Main Inn, The Stone Room comes by its name naturally as its walls are made of fieldstone quarried from the property. Large picture windows overlook a private garden, where many couples have uttered their vows. Intimate gatherings, rehearsal dinners and post-reception breakfasts/brunches for groups of 25 to 60 guests are graciously accommodated in The Stone Room.

Woodsgate

Woodsgate is the most historic of Stroudsmoor's buildings over 200 years old; it creates a unique setting for country celebration with rustic elegance; accommodating groups of 75 to 150 guests. The wedding ceremony is celebrated in the Woodland Chapel, where guests are surrounded by a mountain of trees and sometime a herd of deer. Through its stone wall and ornate iron gates lies an evergreen garden, perfect for outdoor cocktails and Hors d'oeuvres. The cocktail hour continues in the lower level of Woodsgate, where guests enjoy sitting in wing chairs around the stone fire place, listening to a little jazz on the it's vintage piano and mingling at the stone bar illuminated by a 25' chandelier created from twigs and branches gathered from the property. After mingling and nibbling for an hour, guests ascend a spiral staircase to the dining room where oaken beams, bronze chandeliers, magnificent florals and a multitude of flickering candles greet them. Outside window-wrapped dining room a vista of trees makes guest feel as if they are seated in the woods. The upper level of Woodsgate also features a second bar area with fireplace terrace and a bridal lounge for sequestering the bride and her maids before the walk to the altar.

Lawnhaven

Designed to ensure the feeling of an outdoor wedding without the worries of weather, Lawnhaven creates an open-air forum featuring immense stone columns to support a 16' cedar-lined roof. Pewter chandeliers highlight its patterned slate floor and fieldstone hearth. However, the most impressive architectural features of Lawnhaven are the glass walls, which surround the entire building. Walls that look out onto "The Grand Lawn" and an exquisitely appointed garden complete with waterfalls, a grand stair case for the Bride's entrance, a cedar pavilion for the cocktail hour, and stone gazebo for ceremony altar.

Lawnhaven, true to the meaning of its name "sheltered lawn" allows the celebration to continue by protecting its guests from any manner of weather – rain, wind, heat, sleet or snow the wedding goes on without a hitch (save the most important one, the hitching of the Bride and Groom)! Groups of 75 to 150 guests are graciously accommodated for grand outdoor receptions at Lawnhaven.

Ridgecrest

Ridgecrest is one of the largest of Stroudsmoor's private event facilities, gracefully hosting 175 to 250 guests. The celebration begins in Crestview Chapel were the ceremony is held overlooking the newest wildlife sanctuary in the United States, 30,000 acres of protected land featuring mountains and valleys for as far as the eye can see. Following the ceremony guests enter the Ridgecrest cocktail area featuring a 40' stone bar, 12' stone hearth, 6' wrought-iron chandelier and a grand piano. Dinner is served in Ridgecrest's window-wrapped dining room – affording guests panoramic views of the mountains and the valley below. Finally, coach lights line its terrace, where guests are welcome to dance the night away or on occasion enjoy an impressive display of fireworks!

Terraview

The newest addition to the Stroudsmoor premiere event facilities is Terraview. Hosting grand receptions for 200 to 350 guests, this stone castle sits atop the Stroudsmoor Mountain. The building's name, like the others on the Stroudsmoor grounds, tells a story. The etymology of terra is the Latin terrea meaning land and "Terra" in Italian meaning earth or ground. "View" then added simply for the unequaled vistas of the earth seen from its windows. Chapel Terra hosts the celebration ceremony – wedding, commitment, vow renewal and all manners of ritual will be executed in auspicious elegance. The backdrop for the chapel altar is a towering stone wall. Waterfalls flank the altar and formal gardens surround guest seating. The Conservatory at Terraview provides the option of an indoor ceremony – for winter celebrations or inclement weather. The cocktail lounge features 45' mahogany bar, ebony piano, not one, but two stone fireplaces and a grand-wall that will open to reveal the dining room. And yes, in Stroudsmoor tradition, the dining room is wrapped with windows, some towering to its 22' peaked ceiling. The reception area is completed by a 32' x 32' band-shell which invites Terraview's guests to party, party, party!
