Room #1:

This room needs two sets of bunk beds, the bunks need to be lightweight so they can be moved if need be, and also it would be beneficial if they were able to come apart, and be turned into individual beds. The room also needs two smaller dressers, they would ideally be able to fit in a closet to save space, and décor would also be needed (pictures, wall hangings, new light fixture, rugs, etc.)

Room #2:

This room needs one bunk bed, they must be able to come apart and be lightweight. The room needs one small dresser, which is small enough to fit in closet, and décor.

Room #3:

This room needs two sets of bunk beds that are lightweight and have the ability to be stand alone beds. It also needs two small dressers that are small enough to fit in the closet and décor

Room #4:

This room needs one bunk bed, which needs to be lightweight. It also needs an individual bed in twin size. One dresser would be required for this room as well. The dresser can be a little bit larger in than the other rooms. We will also need décor throughout the room.

Room #5: Playroom

This room needs a large interactive rug, along with an interactive table (where kids can sit down and color or make projects) It could also use different organizational methods.

Room #6: Living Room

This room is in high need of some modern decoration, new entertainment center, bookshelves, and couches. We are open to different ideas for this room; let your creative side flow!
