BMCR Pushes Toward Self-Sustainability with BMCR Sunday, February 4, 2018

Nashville, TN, February 2018 - Black Methodists for Church Renewal, an organization that advocates for the unique needs of African American members in The United Methodist Church, has worked to empower its constituency for 51 years. To further its legacy, the organization is promoting BMCR Sunday on February 4th as a way to raise funds on the local level.

To achieve fiscal self-sustainability, BMCR has raised more than \$60,000 in 2017 through various gifts from individuals, local churches, and annual conferences.

“The work of BMCR remains vital to the work of the Church. Financial support throughout the year will ensure that BMCR continues to build on its rich legacy of commitment to leadership development, advocacy, and inclusiveness. The goal for 2018 is \$125,000.
