YOUTH NIGHT

Tuesday night is Youth night!

Youth Night challenges and nurtures boys and girls of all ages 4 yrs. of age thru high school by teaching them to express their value and ambitions toward spiritual, mental, physical and social well-being, and helps them understand their potential as individuals.

Moonbeams: Moonbeams are for 4-year-olds and kindergarteners. The emphasis is on "Doing your best," and badges focus on things which help the children be confident in who God has created them to be.

Sunbeams: Sunbeams are for girls, 1st - 5th grades. The Sunbeam program focuses on helping girls learn about themselves and their world. They do this through programs centered around education, fellowship and worship.

Explorers: Explorers are for boys 1st - 5th grade. The Explorer program focuses on working with others, providing service within the community, learning about other cultures, meeting new people, and building friendships.

Girl Guards: Girl Guards are for middle and high school girls. The Girl Guards program is focused on addressing their spiritual, physical, mental and social needs. Skill-development, personal growth and community service opportunities expand as girls learn to work together and independently in various environments.

Rangers: Rangers are for boy's 6th - 12th grade. The Ranger program focuses on working with others, providing service within the community, learning about other cultures, meeting new people, and building friendships.
