PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Good Neighbor Program

The Good Neighbor program provides emergency assistance to our neighbors experiencing challenges with medical/dental, vehicle repair, housing, energy and other critical needs.

Community Meal Program

Sal's Kitchen is located at our Community Center and provides healthy, nutritious meals at lunch Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Food Pantry and Community Shelf

The Food Pantry provides emergency food baskets Monday & Friday 9:30 - 11:30am and 1-3pm. Fresh perishable food is available Monday - Friday between 9am - 4pm to all in need through the Community Shelf (based on available food).

Pathway of Hope

The Pathway of Hope program provides targeted services to families striving to break free of intergenerational poverty. As families achieve increasing stability, their degree of hope about their futures also increases and serves as motivation along their journey to self-sufficiency.

Community Cares & Seasonal Programs

Our ministry and programs are given freely every day. They include hospital and nursing home visits, Holiday meal baskets, Christmas gift distribution, outreach services and more.

Energy Assistance Program

The Energy Assistance program provides energy assistance through partnerships with People Care, Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP) and other area programs.

Emergency Disaster Services

Our community Emergency Disaster Services program is on the job as soon as disaster strikes. We provide immediate physical, emotional and spiritual assistance as well as hot food and beverages to victims and first responders.

Youth Development

Our weekly Youth programs are designed to challenge and teach youth to express their values and ambitions through positive character-building.

Camp Opportunities
