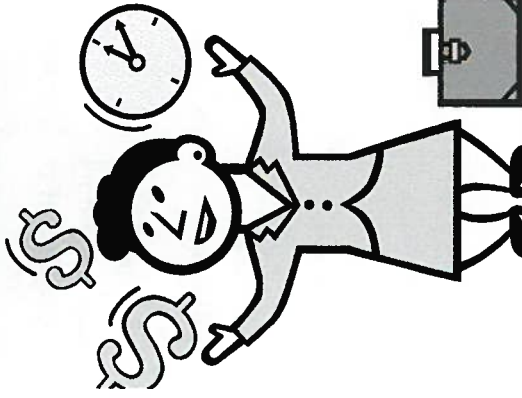

Representative Payee Program Information

The inability to manage money can have a serious negative impact on a person or family. Failure to pay rent and monthly bills can mean loss of utility services, credit termination and eviction.

The Salvation Army's Representative Payee Program offers confidential and compassionate assistance with budgeting your fixed income to meet your basic needs while planning for future goals.



How We Can Help:

A confidential face to face appointment will be scheduled. At the first meeting, sources of income, monthly bills, immediate concerns, and future goals will be discussed and a monthly budget will be established. Budgets are flexible and designed with each individual's needs and goals in mind.

Who Can Receive Services?

Everyone is eligible for our services, based upon the following specific program requirements:

- Clients must receive some type of fixed income each month
- Clients must currently have a payee OR be determined by social security to need a payee
- Clients must be willing to meet with payee for assessment and eligibility for the program
- Clients must be willing to provide all needed information to The Salvation Army Representative Payee staff
