Here's how your gifts have helped The Salvation Army assist needy men, women and children right here in the Fox River Valley.

## During the past year,

- Our volunteers served over **38,249 warm nutritious meals** to neighbors in need.
- In 2015 volunteers bell ringers provided **9,072** hours of their time.
- 2,191 senior residents including 750 veterans at the King Veterans Home were visited. They received 4,382 gifts at Christmas and at Easter through our Community Care Ministries.
- 63 household were assisted by the Project Home, Transitional and Scattered Site housing programs.
- Our annual 2015 Christmas assistance program helped 7,501 individuals in need receive Christmas assistance that saw over 13,690 toys distributed, and some 9,620 books and puzzles helping local children to have a bright Christmas day.
- For the cold Wisconsin winter we distributed over **4,000 warm coats** to needy children.
- Our emergency Food Pantry provided over **1 million pounds** of groceries to more than 7,850 people.
- We will continue to help area men, women and children regain their **hope for a better tomorrow and into the future!**
