

USTA Player Development 2015 Excellence Grants Criteria - Boys

In order to encourage the development of U.S. Junior players we have designed USTA Player Development Excellence Grant criteria to award players for their development to become a professional player. Any U.S. players achieving the requirements listed below (based on a player's birth year) will receive a grant. Players that meet one (1) of the criteria boxes below will receive \$1000, once the player has met two (2) boxes the player will receive \$2000 more and once a player meet three (3) boxes a player will receive \$3000. Thus a player could earn \$6000 during a year based on his/her performance. Player will need to submit this form each time he/she meets one of the requirements listed below.
