Tournament Information

Due to the lack of available courts, entrants must be high school age or above.

Location:

Fishery Park, located just off I-26 in Erwin. Take the Main Street exit (36), turn left, cross the bridge, then turn left again onto Zane Whitson Lane. The courts are on your right.

Time:

Monday through Friday matches will begin at 5:30 pm. (Some may begin earlier if all parties are available). Saturday matches will begin at 8:30 am. Sunday matches will begin at 1:00 pm.

Matches:

All matches will be two sets, with a tiebreaker to 10 points instead of a third set. Please limit warm up time to ten minutes. A fifteen minute default rule will be enforced.

Balls:

Each player must provide one can of USTA approved balls per match. The winner will receive the new can and the loser will keep the used balls.
