What: Social yet competitive co-ed tennis league

When: Mondays at 6:30 PM starting September 11, league play runs 6-8 weeks

Where: Teams choose a facility and play all matches at chosen location.

Location options: Blackburn Tennis Center/Concourse Athletic Club, Piedmont Park (Sharon E. Lester Tennis Center), Terrell Mill Tennis Center in Marietta or Richland courts in Suwanee

<u>How this league is unique</u>: 3 lines of doubles: women's doubles, followed by men's doubles, followed by mixed doubles – 8 game sets with unique rules (players can sub in for one another, each player gets one mulligan, etc.); more beer & more fun with themed nights and social yet competitive atmosphere; end-of-season party at the Red Hare brewery with free pizza & beer for all

<u>Who:</u> 2 divisions: beginner/intermediate (2.5-3.5 rating) & intermediate/advanced (4.0-5.0 rating). A USTA membership is NOT required to participate in this league

Teams: Consist of minimum 3 women and 3 men

<u>Cost:</u> \$60 which covers t-shirt, court fees, balls for all matches, prizes & giveaways throughout season, and end-of-season party at the Red Hare Brewery with free pizza & beer!

From beginners to experienced league players this league welcomes all playing types and styles in a laid back, social atmosphere on Monday nights.

The league is facility-based with players having the option to choose the facility that works best for them. The first match begins at 6:30 PM and the season runs six to eight weeks with an end-of-season party held at the Red Hare Brewing Company located in Marietta. Players & teams are encouraged to visit local bars and grills each week after their matches for food and drink specials and to socialize with other teams.

Registration

Team Captains:

Listed below are the steps a team captain will take with their team:

- 1. Sign-up for TennisPoint (big yellow signup button on http://www.tennispoint.com)
 - a. Visit (www.atlanta.usta.com/RedHareTennis) and get your team signed up by selecting the "Click Here to Register" button, then choosing your desired level and facility your team would like to play out of.
 - Contact **RedHareTennis@gmail.com** if you have questions regarding what level your team should register for.
 - b. You should use the same email you often use and after signing up, your team will be automatically visible in your account.
- 2. Add your team's players -- Add your players using the "add/edit players" link on the "matches & teams" (top tab navigation) page. You only need a player's name and email address to add them to the team. After adding all your players, the checkbox next to their name (in the list on the right side of the page) should be checked since they are probably not yet a TennisPoint member. Click the "send invite email to checked" button and each of your players will receive a customized message inviting them to register and signup for the team. Each player will fill out his/her registration details and be automatically dropped into the team upon registration.

"Find a Team" Players:

- 1. Sign-up for TennisPoint (big yellow signup button on http://www.tennispoint.com)
- Click here to register for either the "Find A Team-Beginner/Intermediate" or "Find A Team-Intermediate/Advanced" level and we will find a team for you to join! Please make the team name your first and last name. Make sure to specify your play level and requested facility.
 - Contact **RedHareTennis@gmail.com** if you have questions regarding which level you should register for.

Match Schedule -- the league coordinator will create the "match schedule" which will show you your opponent, match dates, locations and times. The team schedule is visible from the "matches & teams" page in TennisPoint. Before the schedule is published, you will purely see a list of your players and be able to add/edit your players or e-mail the team.

Match Availability -- each player can mark whether he/she is available or not from the "Set/View Availability" page (link found on the "matches & teams" page above the match schedule on the far left). It can be very helpful on the captain to know who is available to play which match. Availability can ONLY be set after the schedule is published.



We do recommend that after the schedule is published by the league administrator, the captain e-mail the team about the schedule and direct players to set their availability.

Match Lineup – captains and co-captains can all "create lineups". The lineup is the list of players playing each line. Ex) John & Tony at Men's Doubles, Virginia & Laurie at Women's Doubles, Brian & Kristina at Mixed Doubles

Match Confirmation Email - after creating the lineup, you can automatically e-mail all your players alerting them to who is in the lineup. Those in the lineup can also confirm on TennisPoint that they are still available to play and will be there -- this gives a little peace of mind knowing that the player is aware he/she is in the lineup and will be there.

Play the Match -- go have lots of fun and win your matches :-)

Captains are asked to print off a "match scorecard" (PDF file found on TennisPoint) and take it with you to the match so that you can mark down all the match scores. Remember to also fill in your opponent's players who played each line as well since that is required when entering scores. The match scorecard makes this easy and has both team's rosters on the scorecard.

Enter Match Scores -- captains can enter the match scores after the match is played through TennisPoint. Remember to get the names of your opponents since the captain entering the scores will need to enter the opposing players for each line as well. There is an automatic 48 hour auto-approve for the opposing captain after the scores have been entered. Any score conflicts can be edited by the league administrator. If a match is played early, the scores can be entered early as well.

*Note: If incomplete matches remain at the end of the regular season, scores for said matches must be left at 0-0.

Make sure to get your teams signed up ASAP prior to the registration deadline as there are a limited number of team slots available at each facility.
