

Bergen 2014 Local League Regulations

SET TIE BREAKS

In the 1st and/or 2nd set, if you are tied at 6-6, you now play what is called a 12 point tie break. It is the first one to 7 by a margin of 2. Players change ends of the court on multiples of 6. The player that would be starting the next game, starts the tie break by serving once from the deuce side of the court. Staying in serving order, the opponent now serves twice starting from the ad side of the court and the 2nd serve from the deuce side. Each player continues to serve twice following this.

SUPER TIE BREAKS

When splitting sets, you play a "super tie break" in lieu of a third set. A super tie break is the first one to 10 by a margin of 2. You switch sides of the court after the 1st point and then multiples of 4 so you would switch again after the 5th point, the 9th, the 13th, etc. The singles player or the doubles team that would be starting the next set, starts the super tie break. In doubles, either person from the team that serves can start the super tie break. The first server serves once from the deuce side of the court. Switch sides. The opponent now serves twice starting on the ad side of the court. Each player continues to serve twice following this.
