Cure MOMMY's Breast Cancer (CMBC) is a

non-profit charitable organization, formed in 2000 shortly after its founder, Carmela Short, was diagnosed with the disease. The sole purpose of CMBC is to provide financial assistance for living and other expenses to those in need of assistance while suffering the burdens of this disease.

Since its inception, CMBC has raised over \$585,000. CMBC is strictly run by volunteers. Approximately 98 cents of every dollar raised directly helps someone in need. CMBC has assisted in paying: medical insurance premiums, rent and utility bills, home cleaning services, and transportation services. CMBC has granted over \$67,000 in scholarships to qualifying high school students at Plainedge High School.

We are currently a beneficiary organization of the LI2DAY walk to fight breast cancer and are active in many of the planning aspects of the event. CMBC has been part of the walk through team "Bosom Buddies" participation.

Because CMBC is a grass roots organization with all money going to Long Island women, Long Beach Tennis Center proudly supports the organization through sponsoring events throughout the year.
