- 1. Quality of on-court program
- 2. Quality of management structure
- 3. Interaction with parks and recreation department
- 4. Interaction with local tennis association.
- 5. Support of the business community
- 6. Community support of the program
- 7. Ability to raise and administer funding
- 8. Previous nominees may be resubmitted, but it is encouraged for CTA's to find new, deserving candidates.
