



USTA GEPTA JUNIOR SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

The USTA GEPTA honors one junior competitive player annually for continued outstanding conduct at competitive events at the local, state, section and national levels. The award winner in this category will be nominated for the same USTA Southwest Section Award.

PURPOSE: This award is given to a player who not only displays the finest qualities of sportsmanship during tournament play, but who also demonstrates exemplary conduct away from the court as well.

CRITERIA: Among the criteria to be considered when nominating:

1. Current USTA member and resident of GEPTA
2. Current Junior Competitive player ranking
3. Displays respect for opponents, partners, teammates, tournament officials, coaches, chaperones and spectators.
4. Outside activities such as GPA and community/school.
5. Previous nominees may be resubmitted, but new, deserving nominees are encouraged.
