2014 USTA Umpire School Information

1. Referee and ITA Schools
 - a. To get credit for the Referee and/or ITA schools, you must also attend a USTA Officials School.
 - b. First time (new) umpires may only attend the Referee or ITA school with permission of the Missouri Valley Section Chairman of Officials.
2. The 2014 USTA Officials, Referee and ITA tests are to be taken on-line--all test are on the USTA website. http://www.usta.com/About-USTA/Officials/Officials_test_new/.
 - a. These on-line tests are based on the 2014 *Friend at Court*.
 - d. Print the test score(s) and bring to the school(s). No test will be taken in the classroom. If you do not bring the proof the test score to the class, you will be asked to leave and to attend another school when you complete the test.
 - e. **The background check must be submitted in order to attend a school. It does not have to be completed.**
 - f. Class handouts are available on USTA.com; print them out. No handouts will be available at the school (http://www.usta.com/About-USTA/Officials/officials_school_handouts/)
