USTA/MIDWEST SECTION SANCTION REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

The USTA/Midwest Section, as the sanctioning agent for certain USTA tournaments, has established the following Policy as it relates to sanction holders for junior tournaments:

Commencing as of August 17, 2017, all organization members seeking to submit a bid to hold a USTA/Midwest Sanctioned Tournament (whether at the Section, District, or Local level) shall require each member of the Tournament Committee, as defined in USTA Regulations I.B. – I.C., to complete a registration through Net Generation which includes full compliance with the USTA Safe Play requirements.¹ The Tournament Committee must remain in good standing with the USTA Safe Play requirements through the conclusion of the tournament for which the organization member submitted the bid.

The organization member has the affirmative duty to confirm that all Tournament Committee members remain in good standing through the duration of the tournament. The organization member is required to notify the Midwest Section in the event a member's status has changed and immediately replace that Tournament Committee member with the appropriate individual currently listed as in compliance through the Net Generation database or be subject to losing the tournament sanction.

¹ See, USTA Regulation I.B., "Before the start of a tournament, the applicant shall apply for a sanction (see USTA Regulation XVII.) and shall appoint a Tournament Committee of at least three persons. The Tournament Chair, the Tournament Director, and the Referee shall be members of the Committee."
