

# **Drop In Tennis**

Drop In Tennis League is an informal, friendly tennis activity sponsored and run by the City of Albuquerque. One must have a minimum intermediate skill level to qualify, as determined by the Drop-In Coordinator. The cost for each Drop-In sessions is \$3 per person; tennis balls are provided. All participants are expected to abide by the full Drop In Policy.
