



RESERVE A COURT (RAC) PROGRAM

Effective January 1, 2020

1. Captains can participate in a random drawing to reserve specific RAC facilities as their home court for all their matches (home and visitor) during the league season. The RAC facilities that are available for the current league are shown on the ODTA website.
2. Teams that are selected to participate in the RAC program will be charged a RAC Fee (shown below) which covers facility usage and maintenance.

3. To participate in this program, complete the RAC on-line form by the deadline shown on the ODTA website. The on-line form is posted on the league webpage.
4. Captains of the teams selected in the drawing will be required to sign an agreement to abide by "ODTA Tennis Court Rules" (see page 2). Captains will return the agreement and a \$150 deposit by the deadline established by the ODTA.
5. The \$150 deposit less the RAC Fee will be refunded after the conclusion of the league provided no violations of Tennis Court Rules occurred at the assigned courts.
6. Court Monitor
 - The RAC Team Captain/Acting Captain will be the court monitor and will report to the Local League Coordinator (LLC) any infractions of the ODTA Tennis Courts Rules by a team or player.
 - The LLC will inform ODTA and the Section League Coordinator of the infraction.
 - The LLC will provide ODTA the name, address and email address of the violator.
 - If an infraction is committed by the RAC Team, the opposing Team Captain may report the violation(s).
7. A \$50 fine for violation of rules will apply to a player/team captain. If not paid within 10 days of notification, the player/team captain will be suspended from play until the fine is paid. This could be carried over year after year until it is paid.



TENNIS COURT RULES

The following rules apply for all Oahu District Tennis Association league matches to be played at public school and City and County of Honolulu Parks and Recreation tennis facilities. *Private Club rules shall apply for all matches played at club courts.*

1. NO LITTERING – Remove and dispose all litter after your match.
2. NO SPECTATORS allowed inside court area while a match is being played unless agreed upon by both teams.
3. NO DOGS or Animals allowed. *The Honolulu Police Department (911) will respond when a violation is reported.*
4. NO USE of Tobacco Products on school premises and City & County park facilities.
5. NO DRINKING of Alcoholic Beverages. *The Honolulu Police Department (911) will respond when a violation is reported.*
6. NO Glass Bottles or other glass products allowed on courts.
7. NO Skateboarding, Rollerblading, Biking, Baby Carriages, Shoes with Hard Soles/Cleats/Raised Heels allowed on courts.
8. NO LOITERING on school premises after the last match of the day. *The Honolulu Police Department (911) will respond when a violation is reported.*
9. NO CLIMBING up or down court fences or enclosures to retrieve tennis balls or personal items. For your safety, use gates to exit or enter courts. Go around, no fall down!
