RESERVE A COURT PROGRAM

The courts at Castle and Kaiser high schools, and Leeward Community College will be available for Senior Mixed League matches under the "Reserve A Court Program".

How does the "Reserve A Court Program" work?

- 1. Captains can reserve Castle and Kaiser high schools, and Leeward Community College as their home court for all their matches (home and visitor).
- 2. A random drawing will be conducted to determine the (4) teams assigned to each facility. Match start times will be rotated weekly: 7:30am, 9:30am, 11:30am and 1:30pm.
- 3. Captains of the teams selected in the drawing will be required to sign an agreement to abide by school rules (i.e., no alcohol, animals, littering, vandalism, and destruction of property). See ODTA Court Rules on the Senior Mixed webpage.
- 4. Captains will return the agreement and a \$150 deposit by the deadline established by the ODTA.
- 5. The <u>\$150 deposit</u> will be refunded provided no violations of school rules occurred at the assigned courts. *Litter left on the court after a match is considered a violation.*
