

2012 PROGRAM SUMMARY

The following is a listing Down the Line (DTL) offerings to the community in 2012. All programs stress the importance of character, sportsmanship, discipline and responsibility.

YEAR-ROUND CHARACTER CURRICULUM AND JUNIOR AMBASSADOR PROGRAM for youth between the ages of 7 and 17 who already play tennis, which includes mandatory workshops, "homework", community service and social/tennis events.

HOMESCHOOL/PROFESSIONAL PROGRAM for players who are already DTL Ambassadors. This program includes between 2 and 5 discounted practices per week, matchplay opportunities, fitness and mental training and is currently based at Althea Gibson and Levy Tennis Pavilion.

SUMMER CAMP AT EPISCOPAL ACADEMY Our 2012 camp was our first and we had around 30 kids come through our program. We had a base of 6-8 players who came on a regular basis, with additional DTL Ambassadors "dropping in" as well as high-level players traveling through the area.

In addition to our regular programming, Down the Line and Beyond hosted and participated in the following SPECIAL EVENTS THIS YEAR:

SPECIAL STRENGTHS TRAINING WORKSHOP at The Episcopal Academy in conjunction with CITRS. Twenty DTL Junior Ambassadors and Billie Jean King Character Award recipients attended. Participants in the workshop completed a pre-workshop Strengths Assessment and were grouped based on their top strengths.

2ND ANNUAL 10 AND UNDER TEAM TENNIS CLASSIC on The Great Lawn of The Merion Cricket Club. The tournament hosted 70 of the area's best upcoming junior tennis players and emphasized the importance of teamwork, sportsmanship and fun on the tennis court.

DTL Junior Ambassadors participated in a ROUND ROBIN MATCHPLAY with players from VegasTennis.com's Marty Hennessy Jr. Tennis Foundation, which is a Las Vegas based non-profit that supports the development of young tennis players.

DTL Junior Ambassadors participated in the **EXCELLENCE TEAM INITIATIVE** this August, which is a team matchplay based around programs who have a strong group of junior players competing at a high level. Along with DTL, teams included Legacy Youth Tennis and Education, Junior Champions Center, Harlem Junior Tennis Center, New York Junior Tennis League and No Quit Tennis Academy.
