JTT 2020 Championship Year Regulations

For the 2020 Championship Year, USTA SC submits the following regulation additions:

1. USTA SC will follow USTA Southern's addition to JTT regulation 2.03G (2) regarding playing twice (doubling-up). The regulation states:

In Championship play, a team may use different individual players for every line in the team match (singles, doubles and mixed doubles) OR may choose to play one boy and/or one girl twice, in the mixed doubles position only. A team may choose to play players twice regardless of the number of players on the roster; this option is not limited to teams with only 3 boys and/or 3 girls. Players who have played twice in a team competition may not play twice again until after three rounds of competition have been completed by their team. The "playing twice" rotation begins anew in the fourth round of round robin play, and in the Playoff and Final flights.

2. Single gender teams advancing to the USTA SC JTT State Championships must abide by the following guidelines:

To be eligible for State Championship play teams must have a minimum of 5 players on a team, and players are required to play a minimum of 1 team match in their local league. During Championship play teams will play, 3 lines of singles and 2 lines of doubles. The second line of doubles will be played last. Players will not be allowed to play more than two lines in a single team match. If a player is playing twice (or doubling up) in a single team match, he/she must play in the second line of doubles.

- 3. 1.04G(1) All programs advancing teams to State Championship play must qualify per USTA National, Southern and South Carolina regulations. Winners from local seasons are determined by the local league coordinator. Championship berths are determined as follows:
 - a. One berth per season for up to 7 teams
 - b. Two berths per season for 8-12 teams
 - c. Maximum of three berths per season for 13+ teams
