10 and under (green dot balls); **12 and under**; **14 and under**; and **18 and under**.

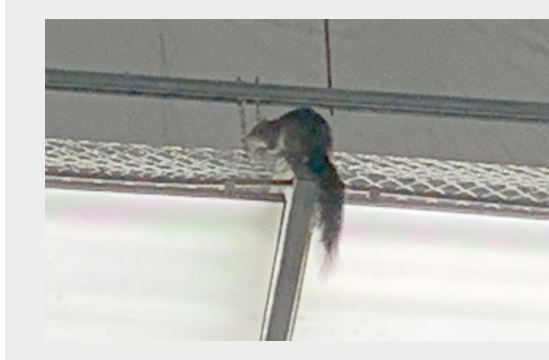
The 10 and 12 divisions will play Saturday, February 29, with the 10s starting at noon and
