Bill Letwin Award Nomination

The Bill Letwin Award, represented by a silver bowl, was established in 1967 by the Town Club, when it was the site of the National Clay Court Tournament. The award is named for Bill Letwin, a retired Milwaukee Journal sportswriter, who covered tennis in Milwaukee for more than forty years before his retirement in 1975. The award is presented annually to recognize "achievement, dedication or service, past or present, by a Wisconsin tennis player, coach, professional, WTA Officer or tournament official".
