

# Wisconsin Tennis Association Community Tennis Connection NEW in 2014!



The Community Tennis Connection brings non-progressive USTA Tennis to your Community and Park and Recreation Department. Let the Wisconsin Tennis Association be your concierge to deliver USTA tennis to fit your community needs.

## <u>Package A – Park and Recreation Department Spring/Summer Program</u>

- Short, 5 week seasons, multiple league offerings
- Set up as a Tri-level program where multiple NTRP players may play together
- League organization could be serviced by a coordinator instead of a captain (concierge service)
- Concierge Service could be provided for a higher league fee
- Must be a registered USTA player
- Multiple leagues could be offered, based on need and desire
- Format of matches developed to fit local leagues: singles, doubles or mixed based on local needs
- Non-progressive leagues allow for flexibility of dates and times for play as well as frequency in a month (ex. 1 match/month vs. 1 match/week)
- Possible State Championship if markets or leagues develop

### <u>Package B – Traditional Progressive USTA Adult League Tennis</u>

Adult Leagues: 18 & Over, 40 & Over, 55 & Over, Mixed 18 & Over, Mixed 40 & Over, Combo Doubles, Tri-Level

# **Winter/Indoor Clubs**

- Similar structure and design as Package A
- Slightly higher fee due to indoor play
- Negotiate set court rates for all players including non-members (for markets where clubs may have unused courts available)
- Wisconsin Tennis Association provides concierge service and organization for clubs who do not have a League Coordinator
