Director of Operations

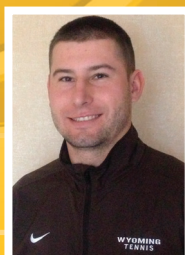

Maciej Bogusz joined Wyoming Cowgirls after 4 years experience as a Tennis Professional at Indian Springs Country Club in Tulsa, Oklahoma. While there, he coached several state and nationally ranked players. As a student-athlete at Lamar University, he was ranked among the Top 25 doubles teams in Division I. He was also First Team All-Southland Conference Selection in 2008. A native of Wroclaw, Poland, he graduated from Lamar University with a degree in Business Administration. Bogusz helped Cowgirls go undefeated in conference season, and finish runner up in MWC tournament. He is PTR certified and he was named 2015 ITA Mountain Division Women's Assistant Coach of the Year.
