

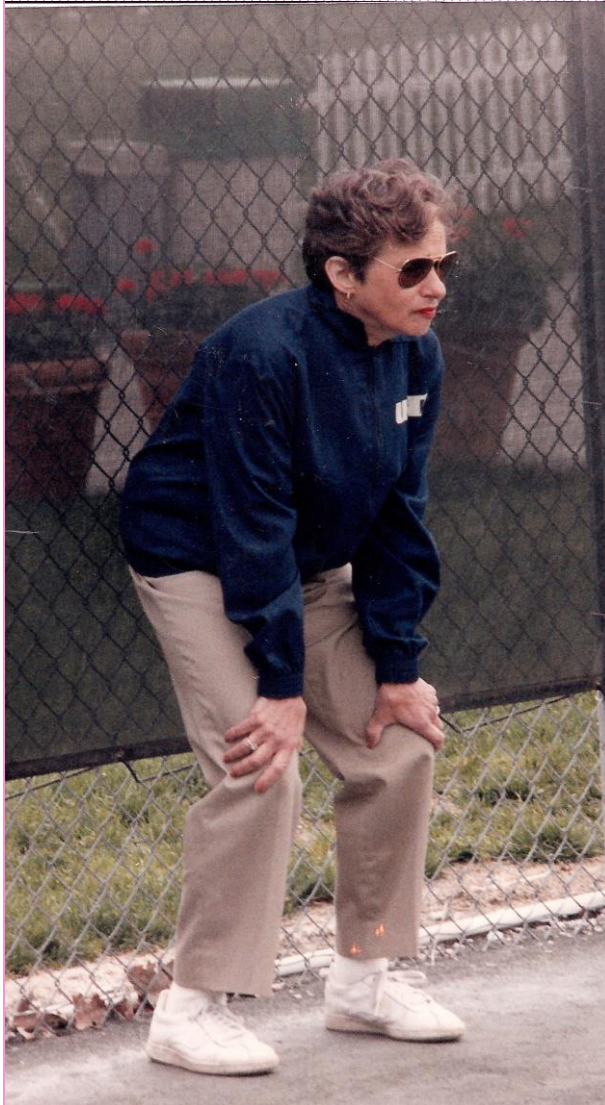


A Chicago District Tennis Legend In Memory of Mary Seelig

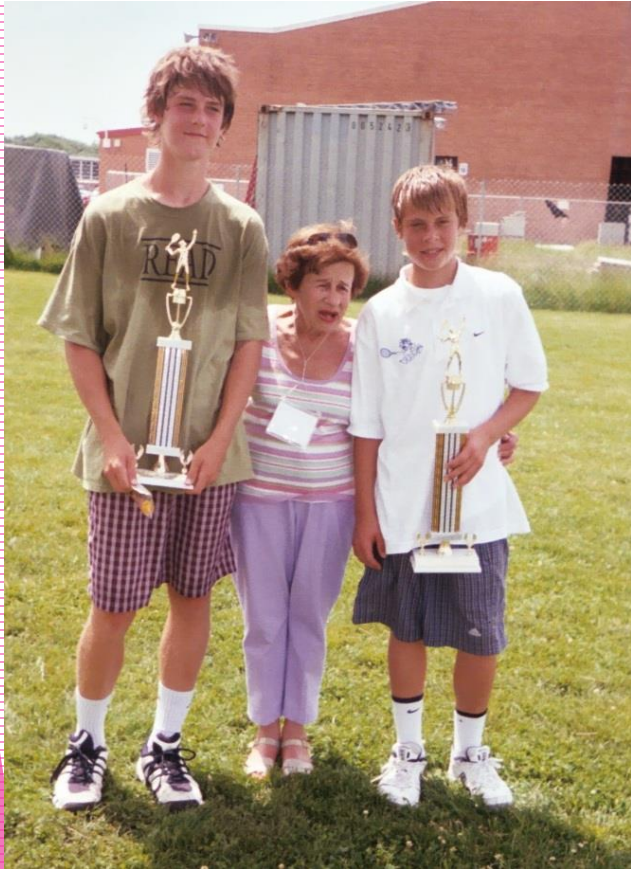


Qualifier Tournament Desk

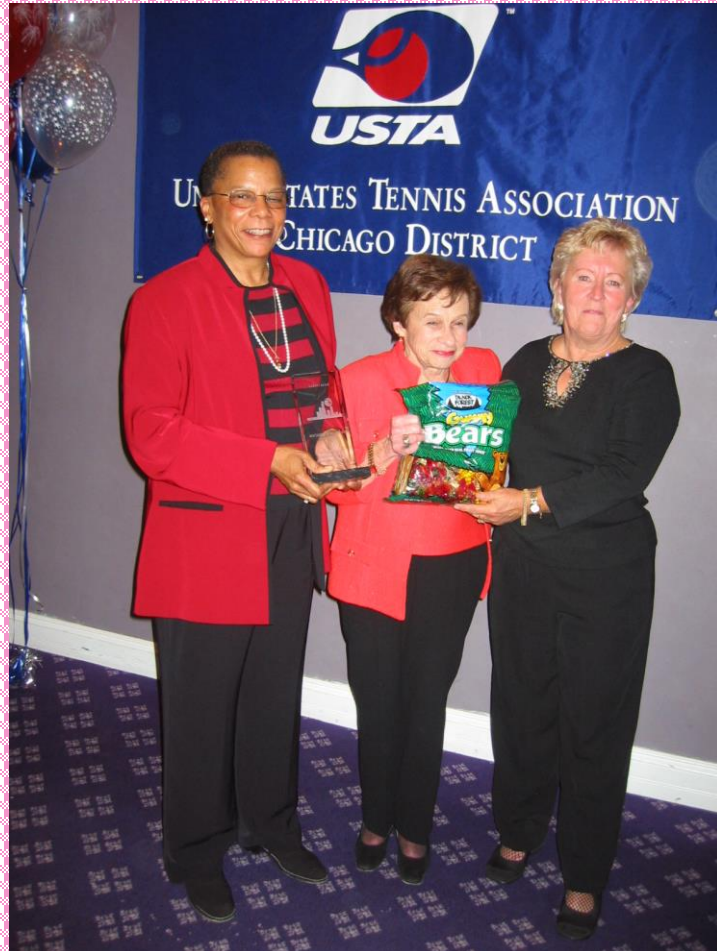
Mary celebrating her 80th Birthday at the Chicago Tennis Patrons Annual Evening of Champions

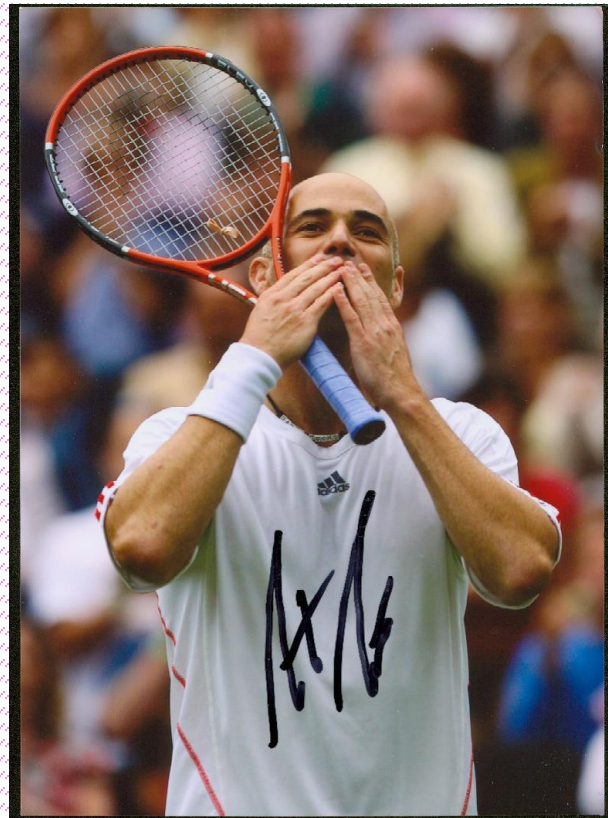
