(NJTL) network is one of the USTA's largest community-based initiatives that for decades has engaged millions of youth through tennis and education programming.

Founded in 1969, Arthur Ashe, Charlie Pasarell and Sheridan Snyder developed NJTL as a way to reach kids with a message of empowerment and purpose. While varying in size and programming, NJTLs provide all kids the access to a progressive pathway of low or no cost community-based after school programming, keeping them healthy, safe and strong.

**Since its beginnings**, the values, ideals and goals set forth by its founders has

provided kids regardless of race, gender or income, with opportunities to develop their individual skills on the court while gaining leadership and academic excellence off the court.

#### INSURANCE

One of the most significant membership benefits for NJTLs and Community Tennis Associations (CTAs) is that they can now operate freely with Liability and Accident insurance provided by the USTA under a low cost Master-policy program which provides coverage against allegations of negligence resulting from bodily injury or property damage. Also, NJTL chapters are eligible for low cost Director's and Officer's Insurance.

The USTA Master Liability and Accident policy provides business insurance benefits for qualified CTAs and NJTLs for:

- USTA and Non-USTA Tennis Activities

- On-Court and Related Off-Court Activities and Events

To celebrate the legacy of humanitarian and tennis great Arthur Ashe, NJTL sponsors an annual essay and art contest throughout the year for children in the participating network. Each year, 10 National essay winners and 4 national art winners have the chance to receive an all-expense paid trip to New York to be guests at Arthur Ashe Kids' Day. We promote the Arthur Ashe Learning Center as a free online resource for children to learn about the life and legacy of the iconic tennis champ.

# NJTL/FIRST SERVE LIFE SKILLS CURRICULUM

This innovative program enables chapters to leverage the lessons of tennis to illustrate the skills, values and experiences to empower youth to become more successful in life.

As kids progress through the curriculum they earn graduation certificates in three levels.

"Game": Kids learn about being a team player, being positive, and understanding the rules. Personal aspects such as practicing proper hygiene, effectively talking with others, and appreciating diversity are also addressed.

"Set" teaches them to embrace fitness, and the role of

nutrition, how to stay calm and focused, while improving study skills, resolving conflict, and dealing with peer pressure.

"Match" requires kids to speak In front of others. It teaches good decision making, and encourages the setting and attaining of personal goals, it helps kids learn how to overcome challenges, and to be more comfortable giving and receiving help.

Kids get a unique opportunity to learn the rewards of personal responsibility and good sportsmanship in a fun and familiar setting. Resources and materials include free training, curriculum, instructor's manual, children's playbooks, T-shirts and graduation certificates.

### **TENNIS LEADERSHIP CAMP**

(TLC) provides NJTL participants with the tennis and social experience of a lifetime. This week long life-changing experience emphasizes character and leadership development, good sportsmanship, physical fitness, proper nutrition, and other healthy attitudes. Tennis is the focus of the week; however, other activities are planned such as career exploration, sightseeing, cultural, sporting, and social events

# PLAYER DEVELOPMENT and NJTL

are working together to identify and develop talent by reaching out to traditionally underserved communities. We test youth through a battery of athletic tests that draw upon general athletic abilities and do not presuppose a history of tennis lessons. Topperforming young athletes are invited to free of charge Regional Training Center Camps, free private training, and even national competition.
