

## **New Points Tables for Level 4 and 5 National Ranking Tournaments Effective January 1, 2005**

*Posted June 8, 2004*

Beginning on January 1, 2005, new points tables will go into effect for the Level 4 and 5 National Ranking Tournaments. Level 4 and 5 Tournaments are Sectional tournaments that have been designated by the Sections as Level 4 and 5 for national ranking purposes. Each Section has four Level 4s and eight Level 5s. The points have been increased in the new point tables so that players will earn more national ranking points for tournaments held in their Sections.

This change is NOT retroactive. All points earned at Level 4 and 5 Tournaments in 2004 will be based on the 2004 point tables – no adjustments to points will be made when these tables go into effect on January 1, 2005. When players play Level 4 and 5 Tournaments beginning in 2005, they will earn the points based on these new point tables.

For example, if a player played placed 2nd at a Level 4 tournament with a FIC through the quarterfinals in February 2004, they earned 90 ranking points based on the 2004 point tables. Those 90 points will remain on the player's record until they roll off in March 2005. If the player has the same result at that February Level 4 tournament in 2005, they will earn 135 ranking points and those points will remain on the player's record for the next 12 months.

Below are the new points tables. Please note that only the points for the Level 4 and 5 Tournaments have been adjusted – no other changes have been made to the point tables.
