The National Public Parks Tennis Championships, created by Dwight Davis (founder of the Davis Cup), began in 1923 as the National Municipal Championships in St. Louis. The event is currently open to players of all ages and abilities. The Greater Stamford Tennis Association (GSTA) and the City of Stamford are proud to bring the event to New England for the first time in its history. In conjunction with the championships, the GSTA and the City are planning a complete renovation of the 12-court facility at Scalzi Park, the hub of public park tennis in lower Fairfield County Connecticut.
