A USTA Kids' Tennis Club is a group of 10 and Under Tennis players meeting regularly to have fun, sample tennis, and develop a passion for the game. The Kids' Club program is available to any school, individual, organization, or facility with regular access to a space in which a 10 and Under Tennis court can be set up.

- Minimal instruction
- No documented results
