Equipment Incentive Grades K - 5

Requirements:

- 5 player minimum
- 12 meetings a year minimum

Equipment Starter Kit includes:

- 12 racquets (21" and 23")
- 36 10U approved balls (Red & Foam)
- Roll of tennis caution tape

Equipment Incentive Grades 6 - 12

Requirements:

- 5 player minimum
- 12 meetings a year minimum

Equipment Starter Kit includes:

- 12 racquets (25")
- 36 10U approved balls (Orange & Green)
- Roll of tennis caution tape

Returning KTC (Existing KTC)

Requirements:

- Must have an ongoing KTC
- 5 player, 12 meeting minimum

Returning KTC kit includes

- 36 10U approved balls
- Listed benefits above + additional games
- KTC player prizes

- 4.) Following USTA National's confirmation, you will receive an email from USTA Texas with 3 question you will need to answer in order to receive the equipment package.

2. Login to your current account or create a new profile. If you are a current KTC skip to step 4.

3. Everyone must fill out profile information.

If you are a school provider follow these instructions:

*If you are offering your KTC during school hours and would like for your equipment and supplies to go to the school's address choose the **Schools** box and click **Lookup** to find your school.

If you have searched and have not found your school choose the **Add School button. A separate screen will pop up.
