

1993 Hall of Fame Inductee: Thomas Jefferson Glover

Jeff Glover: Jeff started playing tennis at age 13 in Boston and later moved to the Southwest. He was a highly ranked player in the Southwest from 1952-1969. He later found success at the national level earning rankings in the top ten for 12 years. Furthermore, his dedication to the sport brought him to a tennis career off the court by serving as Phoenix District Tennis Association Vice President and later as Southwest Section President from 1958-1963. Jeff played tennis until he was 95 years old.
