



2017 Oahu District Tennis Association (ODTA) Youth Tennis Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

To provide financial assistance to enable participation in youth tennis programs and events in Oahu.

SCHOLARSHIPS (on a funding available basis)

Individual Scholarships – Four (4) Individual Scholarships available. Scholarship amount is \$500 and must be used for expense to national or inter-island tennis events. The selection will be based on both tennis performance and financial need.

ELIGIBILITY

To qualify, applicants must:

- ☐ Be a current Oahu resident.
- ☐ Be age 18 or younger.
- ☐ Demonstrate financial need.
- ☐ Demonstrate motivation and responsibility.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- ☐ A completed scholarship application form signed by a parent or guardian.
- ☐ A Proof of financial need.

Acceptable documents include:

Student Aid Report (SAR) from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

W-2 Form

2 current consecutive pay stubs

Unemployment Statements

Any document that indicates currently receiving financial assistance from school/government/company

Official letter from school employee, social worker, or case worker verifying eligibility

- ☐ OPTIONAL – a recommendation letter from the tennis coach is highly suggested.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Complete the Youth Tennis Scholarship Application Form, which must be signed by a parent/guardian.

RECIPIENT'S RESPONSIBILITY

All scholarship recipients are

- ☐ Required to attend and complete the programs/events for which the scholarship is awarded. Failure to meet this requirement will result in the loss of scholarship.
- ☐ Required to submit the receipt of the registration/program fee or travel expense for the national tennis event.
- ☐ Required to submit one-page summary of the experience learned from the attended program/event.
- ☐ Provide minimum of 8 hours volunteer work to help promote tennis on Oahu.
