Congratulations on advancing to the second round of the 2016 Family Classic. The **Regional Tournament** will be held at the **Yale University Tennis Courts** (New Haven, CT). You will be competing against other teams from New England & the tri-state area who won their local event.

All Father/Child Teams – SATURDAY, JULY 30

All P/C 10 & Under Teams – SATURDAY, JULY 30

All Mother/Child Teams – SUNDAY, JULY 31

All Husband/Wife Teams – SUNDAY, JULY 31

All Parent/Child Open Teams – SUNDAY, JULY 31

Brackets will be posted by Wednesday, July 27. Please visit www.ctopen.org for tournament information and complete brackets under the Family Classic tab. All finalists at the Regional Tournament will be eligible to advance to the **CT Open Family Classic Finals**, scheduled for **THURSDAY, AUGUST 25** during the **CT Open Tournament**. The finals will be played during the afternoon session beginning at 2pm at the Yale Tennis Courts (the same courts used for the Connecticut Open). Winners and finalists will be invited to participate in the stadium-court recognition later that evening. If you advance to the finals, you should plan for both an afternoon and evening at the CT Open on Thursday, August 25th.

Please be sure to review the following event **ELIGIBILITY RULES** as they pertain to teams advancing to the Regional Tournament:

- Children must play with their Parent, Grandparent or Legal Guardian. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- The age-eligibility of the child is based upon their age on JULY 1st Ex. if your child was 14 on the day you won your local Family Classic event, but turns 15 before July 1st, they must compete in the 18/Under division)
- Anyone with a **TOP-10 USTA JUNIOR STANDING** or a team that has won two or more years in the same division **MUST play up one** age division or in the Parent/Child Open Division.
- **Teams and participants may not participate in multiple Family Classic events.** A team is eligible to play in only **one event** at the regional tournament.
- Runner-up teams from local events may advance to the Regional Tournament if the winning team is unable or ineligible to advance.
- The Parent-Child 10 & under division will be played with a green-dot ball at the Regional Tournament.

Directions to the Yale University / CT Open Tennis Courts

From Points West (Fairfield County, CT)

Via I-95 NORTHBOUND

Take Exit 44, bear right, and take first left onto Ella T. Grasso Blvd (Rt. 10). Follow the Blvd. then turn left onto Derby Ave. Drive ¼ mile and you will see the entrance to the Yale Athletic Complex on the right (just past the Yale Baseball Field on the left and the large columns on the right)

Via Rt. 15 NORTHBOUND (Merritt Parkway)

Take Exit 57 (Derby Ave. / Rt. 34 East). Drive 4 miles and the entrance to the Yale Athletic Complex on the left. If you drive past the Yale Baseball Field on the right and the large columns on the left, turn around, you've gone too far!

From Points North/East (Boston, MA) (Rhode Island)

Via I-95 SOUTHBOUND

Take Exit 45, go straight on Ella T. Grasso Blvd. (Rt. 10). Follow the Blvd. then turn left onto Derby Ave. Drive ¼ mile and you will see the entrance to the Yale Athletic Complex on the right (just past the Yale Baseball Field on the left and the large columns on the right)

From Points North (Hartford, CT) (Central MA)

Via I-91 SOUTHBOUND

Take Exit 1 (Rt. 34 West) then take Exit 3. Continue straight for 1 mile then take a left onto Ella T. Grasso Blvd. (Rt. 10). Turn left onto Derby Ave. Drive ¼ mile and you will see the entrance to the Yale Athletic Complex on the right (just past the Yale Baseball Field on the left and the large columns on the right)

Via Rt. 15 SOUTHBOUND (Wilbur Cross Parkway)

Take Exit 58 (Derby Ave. / Rt. 34 East). Drive 4 miles and the entrance to the Yale Athletic Complex on the left. If you drive past the Yale Baseball Field on the right and the large columns on the left, turn around, you've gone too far!
