In order to receive the **travel stipend assistance grant the coach must:

- 1) Be a member of the USTA
- 2) Be making a living as a full-time tennis coach;
- 3) Attend the Australian, Roland Garros or Wimbledon during the junior tournament competition to assist his/her player;
- 4) Submit W-9
- 5) Submit the attached form along with a copy of his/her flight itinerary.
