EXPERIENCE LEVEL: These tournaments are for the junior player with some tournament experience. Age groups 14-18 will compete with the Yellow ball. 12s will compete with the Green Dot ball. 10s will compete with the Orange ball. Players must compete in age group of their current age. No “Playing Up” for any age group.

CHALLENGER DEFINITION

A Challenger is a novice player who has not won an open tournament. A junior may continue to participate in challenger events, in their age appropriate division, until they have won no more than (2) Challenger Tournaments. After two (2) Challenger Tournament wins, a junior is no longer eligible for a Challenger event until they age up. A player may not play out of his/her age division in a Challenger event until the month in which the junior ages up. Players must compete in the age group of their Current age. No “Playing Up” for any age group.

10's Challenger will be best of 3 short sets (first to 4 games). If the score reaches 3-3 in games, a 7 point tiebreak will be played to determine the winner of that set. Matches will be no-ad scoring, with a 7 point Tiebreak played in lieu of the 3rd set.
