

SOUTHERN GEORGIA

Tournament Criteria for USTA Georgia JR Super Championship Tournaments Georgia Level 3

- 1. The tournament must meet "Requirements for All USTA Georgia Sanctioned Junior Tournaments."
- 2. The tournament must use at least one USTA-certified official (separate from referee) for each eight (8) courts used, per site.
- 3. USTA Georgia seeks to spread events throughout the state and throughout the year.
- 4. Tournaments must be "open." Singles Only, Age Divisions BG 10-18.
- 5. Tournaments held in June and July ONLY may offer Doubles. Events are limited to 3 days, with 32-draws in Singles and 16-draws in Doubles.
- 6. Draw size: Minimum of 16 (for a 2-day event) and maximum of 32 (for a 3-day event in the summer or on a federal Monday holiday weekend). No overflow draws are permitted.
- 7. Tournament format:
 - 4 16 −draw Singles format: Saturday-Sunday; Full FIC and ¾ playoff in the main draw
 - ♣ Scoring Format for Boys/Girls 12-18: Main Draw & Consolation 2 out of 3 sets with a 3rd set ten (10) point "Match" tie-break
 - Boys/Girls 10s: Main Draw & Consolation Short Sets with a 3rd set seven (7) point "Match" tie-break. Tournament notes must state that 3 FIC matches will be played on Sunday to complete the FIC
 - 32-draw Singles format: Saturday-Monday; Full FIC and ¾ playoff in the main draw
 - Scoring Format for Boys/Girls 12-18: Main Draw & Consolation 2 out of 3 sets with a 3rd set ten (10) point "Match" tie-break
 - Boys/Girls 10s: Main Draw & Consolation Short Sets with a 3rd set seven (7) point "Match" tie-break Tournament notes must state that FIC finals will not be played
 - ↓ 16-draw Doubles format: Saturday Monday; June and July only.
 - ♣ Scoring Format for Boys/Girls 12-18 8-game pro-sets.
 - ♣ Scoring Format for Boys/Girls 10 6-game no-ad set with a seven (7) point "Match" tie-break played at 6-all.
- 7. Trophies must be provided for 1st and 2nd place, both main draw and consolation; awards to the ¾ playoff are optional.
- 8. The tournament must supply new USTA-approved balls for each match (BG 10 18) suitable to the surface and age division.
 - 12U must be played on 78' court with yellow balls

- 10U will be tagged Green Level 1 and played on 78' court with green dot balls.
- 10U Orange 1 may be offered in additional if court availability allows. In this case, players will receive level 4 ranking points.
- 9. Tournaments must use a standard deadline of 9 days before the start of the tournament.
- 10. Selections made and published 6 days prior to the start of the tournament and draws posted 2 days prior to the start of the tournament. The USTA Georgia staff may assist in the Selection process.
- 11. Selection and Seeding Guidelines:
 - ♣ All USTA Georgia Level 3 events that do not have Southern Level 3 points or higher should make player selections using Georgia Standings.
 - Players are primarily seeded using Georgia Standings.
 - Additional guidelines:
 - Out of state players...
 - A player from outside Georgia (or one who has recently moved to Georgia) may be considered for seeding based on his/her Southern or National standing by comparing his/her standing to the standings of those being considered for seeding based on Georgia Standings.
- 12. The tournament must have a process for alternates.
- 13. Entry fee may be no more than the following:
 - \$45.00 with a t-shirt for BG 12-18s (tournaments offering Singles only)
 - \$35.00 with a t-shirt for BG 10s (tournaments offering Singles only)
 - \$50.00 with both a t-shirt and doubles for BG 12-18s (during June or July only)
 - \$40.00 with both a t-shirt and doubles for BG 10s (during June or July only)
- 14. Refund policy regarding inclement weather must be posted on the tournament website by the close of entries.
- 16. In order to be specified as a USTA Georgia Junior Super Championship tournament, the above guidelines must be followed.
