Team Georgia Southern Ozaki Junior Cup (SOJC)

Selection Process for SOJC Team Georgia

The Southern Ozaki Junior Cup is a team competition for ages 12-18 that is held annually. Each age group is comprised of three boys and three girls to represent Georgia. The Southern Ozaki Junior Cup Tournaments are played on consecutive weekends with the 12s and 14s playing the first weekend and the 16s and 18s playing the second weekend. An alternate for each age/gender group is recommended. Selections are based on the following criteria:

- 1. Only players with no more than five (5) active Suspension Points are eligible for selection.
- 2. Standings of players on the first Southern Standings list following the National Hard Courts.
- 3. National rankings, UTR ratings, Tennis Recruiting information, Head to Head results and Doubles rankings are also considered in making the final selections.

Selections are made by a subcommittee of 3 members of the Junior Competition Committee who report their findings back to the Committee for a final vote.

Information about the Southern Junior Cup is sent to prospective selectees prior to the National Clay Courts in July. Final selections are made in August by the Selection Committee.
