

THE RULES HAVE CHANGED! IT'S A WHOLE NEW BALL GAME FOR KIDS TENNIS

- **Smaller and lighter racquets adjusted to a child's size**

This new play format designed for kids 10 and under makes it easier for kids to pick up a racquet and have fun right away—even if they've never played before. Now that's something to make a racquet about.

18' x 21' singles 18' x 27' doubles	up to 25"	An orange low compression felt ball moves a little faster and travels farther but still has a lower bounce than the standard yellow ball.	3'

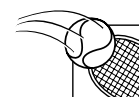
Midwest Section has appointed Ron Brooks as the liaison for this project. Ron, a Past President of Midwest Section, has been attending our MITA Board meetings for several years. Ron's volunteer achievements are too numerous to list. I am grateful for the help he has given us to work through some of the details of this possible merger. I asked Ron to add a few comments on the advantages of a MITA/SITA merger.

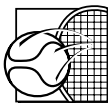
The following is his response:

- As a combined District, total membership and adult membership would move the combined districts to the 10th largest and 9th largest in junior membership. Larger membership and growth equates to more revenue to support programs.
- Stronger Junior Teams—Grow Junior “Quota”
- A single full time Executive Director (establish office for better organizational excellence, use of information technology, and better delivery system)
- A combined Board of Directors would provide greater leadership within the tennis family (better succession opportunities/financial planning)
- A larger volunteer base to grow the game (tap synergies of existing volunteer structure—develop a retention initiative)
- Financial stability and resources available to “grow the game”
- A stronger delivery system to refocus existing CTA's on delivering “participation” in our programs
- A shared desire for change and improvement
- Development of programs to build and/or refurbish tennis courts and backboards in selected areas
- Development of an interactive web site with new resources

I welcome your comments and feedback as we move forward on this project.

**USTA PLAYER DEVELOPMENT COMPETITION TRAINING CENTER****2011/2012 MITA/SITA Competition Training Center**

The Decatur Athletic Club in Decatur, Illinois is an official USTA Player Development Competition Training Center (CTC). The facility functions as a center for junior training and development as prescribed by the USTA Player Development Program. The goal of each CTC is to help the 20 most promising amateur players in Middle and Southern Illinois reach their maximum potential. There are approximately 100 USTA CTCs across the United States, three of which are in Illinois (2-Chicago area, 1-Middle and Southern Illinois).

USTA trained coaches and will operate the local CTC program. Players involved will train using a USTA curriculum, have their development tracked, and receive sport-related guidance for themselves and their parents. The CTCs are designed to supplement local excellence programs or tennis academies where players may be training on a daily basis. Participants will pay a \$285 fee for this training. Chuck Kuhle of Decatur serves as Head Coach and Administrator of the CTC and recruits the various USPTA and PTR coaches from the Central and Southern Illinois region. The Middle Illinois and Southern Illinois Tennis Associations as well as several community tennis associations have donated funds in the past for court time expenses. To make a donation, please contact Chuck Kuhle. The 2011-2012 session dates held at the Decatur Athletic Club will be announced on the Middle Illinois website in September 2011.

In addition, the CTC sends two boys and two girls to a Midwest Level 4 Competition Training Center Tournament in April, 2012 to represent our center.

Selection Process for the USTA Player Development Competition Training Center/Decatur, Illinois

To be selected for the 2011-12 USTA CTC, the following selection process will be used:

Twenty players to be selected:

Boys:

- Two players selected born on or after 9/1/00
- Two players selected born on or after 9/1/99
- Three players selected born on or after 9/1/98
- Three players selected born on or after 6/1/97

Girls:

- Two players selected born on or after 9/1/00
- Two players selected born on or after 9/1/99
- Three players selected born on or after 9/1/98
- Three players selected born on or after 6/1/97

Selection process:

The selection will be based on the last published 2011 Midwest standing list as of August 31, 2011. A player must reside in the counties of the MITA or SITA. The selected players will be published on the MITA and SITA website approximately September 30, 2011.

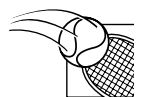

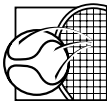

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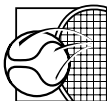

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About USTA Jr. Team Tennis

USTA Jr. Team Tennis brings kids together in teams to play singles, doubles and mixed doubles against other teams. It promotes social skills and important values by fostering a spirit of cooperation and unity, as well as individual self-growth. Also, it's a fun environment for kids in which they learn that succeeding is really more about how they play the game – win or lose.

How does it work?

USTA Jr. Team Tennis is designed for kids ages 5-18. They are immediately placed on teams. All you need to start a league are two teams. Matches can be held anywhere from a local park or school to a commercial or private club. Teams are preferably co-ed but can also be single gender (boys only or girls only). They are divided by the following age and play levels:

Age Groups: U18, U16, U14, U12, U10 and U8

Play Levels: Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced

All players have access to TennisLink, the USTA's online player registration system. TennisLink allows registered players to keep track of their records and stats, as well as scout their competition. The costs to participate can vary by local market. Minimum fees include costs for the official uniform, USTA membership (if new member), plus nominal shipping and processing fees.

Although David Welch has been an athlete his entire life, he came to tennis late.

David grew up in rural Logan County, Illinois near Elkhart. He attended Mt. Pulaski High School where his basketball team won the Illinois State High School Championship his junior year and finished fourth his senior year. He went on to play college basketball at Illinois Wesleyan in Bloomington.

At age 25, David began playing the king of sports. However, tennis was initially just a summer sport for David, with his main passion being platform tennis.

David discovered platform tennis in 1989 at Washington Park in Springfield, Illinois. He quickly became a fanatic. In making many calls per week to set up matches, he single-handedly doubled or tripled the number of platform tennis players in Springfield.

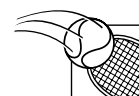
Through the internet, David found a platform tennis tournament in St. Louis and signed up for it in 1995. That first St. Louis tournament exposed David to a higher level of play. Through observation and getting to know top notch out of town players, David imported to Springfield new techniques and a higher level of platform tennis skill. As a direct result, Springfield Platform Tennis players have since won many matches (and more than a few titles) in platform tennis tournaments in St. Louis, Kansas City, Chicago, Milwaukee, Indianapolis, Grand Rapids, Michigan and Cincinnati, among other places. Also, thanks to David's promotion of Springfield platform tennis, we now have an annual tournament, which has been participated in by players from St. Louis, Kansas City, Chicago and Madison, Wisconsin, among other places.

In 2008, due to an ever more painful hip, David had hip replacement surgery. The surgery was successful, so successful that a couple of months after getting a bionic hip, he was playing singles again at a very high level.

Unfortunately, however, David's new hardware did not take well to platform tennis. After playing another season, he retired from platform tennis and became involved in USTA league play. With his usual high energy, intensity, and focused dedication, he single-handedly organized and managed several USTA men's tennis teams with significant early success. He captained a 3.5 Senior men's team to a second place finish at Section this past summer and his 8.5 Men's Combo team just won Section at Ft. Wayne. He plays on the 8.0 Sr. Mixed team captained by Kathy Sigle that is headed for National's in April.

In conclusion, we wholeheartedly support the nomination of David Welch for the USTA Volunteer of the Year award because David has single-handedly increased both the quantity and quality of Springfield tennis — first on the platform tennis courts and now, year round, in regular tennis. As a result, we are all playing at a higher level, with faster feet, fewer pounds, and a better, more interesting life. Thank you David.

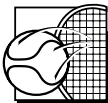
