10 & UNDER TENNIS

Scoring

The QuickStart Tennis format has a scoring system that is very simple. It helps kids understand the structure of the game and allows them to keep track of the competition as it unfolds. Conveniently, it also gives parents and players a start and finish time.

For the 10 and under age group, children play the best of three sets and the first to win four games wins a set. For the third set, the first player to win the seven points wins the match.

Balls

Kids need a ball that is sized and paced to their playing abilities. A regulation tennis ball moves too fast, bounces too high and is too heavy for the smaller racquet. Each age group, therefore, uses a ball better suited to their size and unique playing ability. For children aged 10 and under, a low-compression ball moves a little faster and travels farther than the ball used with the younger group, but it still has a lower bounce than a regulation ball.

Racquets

For an adult player to succeed at tennis, racquet control is essential. Same goes for kids. However, since kids are smaller than adults, kids have trouble controlling full-size racquets. They're too long, too heavy and the grips are too large. Kids need racquets that are proportionate in length and weight and have a grip that fits their smaller hands. For children aged 10 and under the appropriate racquet size should be 23" or 25".

Courts

Children aged 10 and under will play on a 60-foot long court.

2013-14 USTA/MID-SOUTH ILLINOIS COMPETITION TRAINING CENTER

The Decatur Athletic Club in Decatur, Illinois, is the official MSITA Competition Training Center. The facility functions as a center for junior training and development for the 20 most promising 10-14 year olds in the district. The goal of the CTC is to help these amateur players reach their maximum potential through competitive drill and match play. Chuck Kuhle, USPTA Master Professional and USTA High Performance Coach, will head the group of instructors in the training of these players.

The CTC is designed to supplement the local excellence programs or tennis academies where players may be training on a daily basis. Participants will pay a \$300 fee for this training which involves a 50-hour curriculum over four separate weekends between October 2013 and February 2014. The 2013-14 session dates held at the Decatur Athletic Club will be announced on the Mid-South Illinois website in September 2013.

Selection Process for the USTA/Mid-South Illinois Competition Training Center

To be selected for the 2013-14 CTC, the following selection process will be used: Twenty players to be selected:

Boys:

Two players selected born on or after 9/1/02 but on or before 8/31/03 Two players selected born on or after 9/1/01 but on or before 8/31/02 Two players selected born on or after 9/1/00 but on or before 8/31/01 Three players selected born on or after 9/1/99 but on or before 8/31/00

Girls:

Two players selected born on or after 9/1/02 but on or before 8/31/03 Two players selected born on or after 9/1/01 but on or before 8/31/02 Two players selected born on or after 9/1/00 but on or before 8/31/01 Three players selected born on or after 9/1/99 but on or before 8/31/00

The selection will be based on the last published 2013 Midwest standing list as of August 31, 2013. A player must reside in the counties of the MSITA district. The selected players will be notified no later than September 30, 2013.

2013-14 USTA/MID-SOUTH ILLINOIS CUP TEAM TRAINING CENTER

The Atkins Tennis Center in Champaign, Illinois, is the official site of the MSITA Cup Team Training Center. The facility functions as a center for junior training and development for the top 15-18 year olds in the district. The goal of the CTTC is to help these amateur players reach their maximum potential through competitive drill and match play. Christine Stromberg, Program Coordinator-Assistant Pro, will head the group of instructors in the training of these players.

The CTTC is designed to supplement the local excellence programs or tennis academies where players may be training on a daily basis. This program is used in the selection criteria for the Marian Wood Baird Cup Team and the Boys' 18 Cup Team for MSITA. Participants will pay a \$120 fee for this training which involves a 15-hour curriculum over three separate weekends between October 2013 and January 2014 for the boys and January 2014 and April 2014 for the girls.

There will be two sessions of boys only, one session of mixed, and two sessions of girls only. The 2013-14 session dates will be announced on the Mid-South Illinois website in September of 2013.

To be selected for the 2013-14 CTTC, the following selection process will be used: A maximum of 30 players to be selected:

Boys: 15 players selected born on or after 7/1/95 but on or before 8/31/99 Girls: 15 players selected born on or after 7/1/95 but on or before 8/31/99

The selection will be based on the last published 2013 Midwest standings list as of August 31, 2013. A player must reside in the counties of the MSITA district and be a US citizen (US Birth Certificate, US Passport, valid Alien Registration Card, I-485 Letter). A selected player will be notified no later than September 30, 2013.





Cap Leighton Award - Chuck Kuhle, Decatur, IL

The Cap Leighton Award recognizes the tennis teaching professional who contributes to tennis in his or her community beyond his livelihood. This person gives freely in promoting involvement in tennis for players of all levels and ages, and assists in developing tennis programs and participation in these programs.

Kuhle has been instrumental to the growth and vitality of tennis in the Decatur area through his position as a tournament director and tennis professional.

Kuhle and his passion for tennis benefitted the former Middle Illinois Tennis Association (MITA is now part of the Mid-South Illinois Tennis Association) for almost 20 years. In addition to his Director of Tennis positions at Decatur Athletic Club and Decatur Park District, he is active in tennis initiatives outside his work responsibilities.

Kuhle has served as tournament director for the USTA Men's \$10,000 Pro Circuit Futures in Decatur for the past 15 years. He also oversees all tennis programs which take place at two area facilities. In addition to these responsibilities, he volunteers his time at the USTA, USTA/Midwest Section, and District levels. Kuhle is currently a USTA Pro Circuit Committee member and USTA/Midwest Section Nominating Committee member. His contributions throughout the District include past involvement on the Board of Directors and volunteer on various committees.

Also, Kuhle has spoken at USPTA and USPTA Midwest Division conferences, and written articles for inclusion in both organization's publications. His honors include being named the 2008 Racquet Sports Industry Magazine Junior Development Champion of the Year, and 2002 and 2006 USPTA Illinois State Professional of the Year. Kuhle has trained and positively impacted hundreds of USTA, USTA/Midwest Section, and District level players over the years.

Stanley Malless Award – Eric Schacht, Champaign, IL

The Stanley Malless Award is presented to a volunteer recognizing distinguished service in his or her district. The award especially honors the individual who has contributed to the development of tennis programs from the grass roots up for five years or more.

Schacht led the launch to form the Mahomet Community Tennis Association in 2009 to introduce tennis to this area with few tennis courts and no high school team. During the past five years more than 30 junior high and high school girls have participated in a program designed with the team concept. Schacht's dedication to working with the girls in the program has led to them recently playing competitive matches against area clubs, tournaments, and invitational events.

Two years ago, the Mahomet CTA started offering a Midwest Youth Team Tennis program targeting youth 10 years of age and younger. Approximately 60 children participated in the summer program in 2012, and the successful program will again be offered in 2013.

Schacht has been coaching girls' tennis teams for several years, and was previously the coach at two area high school teams. He also served as a volunteer coach for the University of Illinois women's collegiate team.




