Score Entry

This responsibility should be discussed when lineups are exchanged. Both captains should retain a copy of the match lineup and scores throughout the entire season in case of a dispute.

If something is incorrect with the match as entered, please dispute the match and send an email to the appropriate league coordinator to explain the reason for the dispute.
