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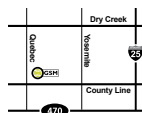

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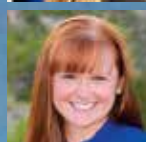
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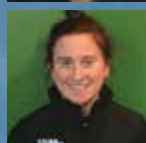

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COMMUNITY

NEW in 2019: Adopt a Court grant deadlines will be eliminated and applications accepted on an ongoing basis with money awarded on a first-come, first-served basis (*Adopt a Court grants remain a matching grant for the repair and renovation of existing public tennis courts*).

RETURNING: Grant applications are no longer necessary for potential community funding. Money is available on a first-come, first-served basis to help create new and enhance existing community tennis programs.

The CYTF offers Program Grants (awarded to organizations that are developing or expanding tennis programs available to youth) and Individual Player Scholarships (providing funds to players of all abilities, age 18 years and under, who demonstrate financial need).

The deadline to apply for financial aid is March 1 (Primary deadline) and September 1 (Secondary deadline).



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YOUTH ORGANIZED PLAY

When kids first pick up a racquet, it opens a door to a **lifetime of fitness, friendships and fun**. That first encounter — whether it's on the playground or in the gymnasium at school, on a driveway or against a garage door, or with a tennis teacher at your local court — is just the first step to developing a youngster's interest in a sport that can help transform them for life. Once your child has developed the basics, USTA Colorado helps coordinate numerous opportunities for sparking that interest into a blazing passion.

TEAM CHALLENGE

The new Net Generation experience — Team Challenges — are low-pressure, team environments that allow children to develop their skills through level-based play without an emphasis on instruction or results! This experience is for **RED, ORANGE**, and **GREEN** ball, and is designed for players before moving on to JTT or tournaments. Participants are expected to at least drop hit serve from the service line over the net and sustain a modified rally which can be rolling, trapping, bumping, or hitting.

Designed to be delivered as a single event or a series of up to six events, with the objective of providing a fun and social environment that highlights character and skill development. It is a fantastic way to introduce a lifelong love of the game from the very first play opportunity!

Colorado has the largest Junior Team Tennis program in the country, and with two seasons to choose from (Summer and Fall), we are looking to build on that tremendous success.

Teams of 4-6 players play against other teams of similar age and

skill on a weekly basis. Teams competing in the Summer season can earn a spot in the State Championship (August).

A new format has been put in place for select entry-level tournaments this year. Team Tournaments are an innovative way for youngsters to gain match experience, develop their skills through level-based play, and demonstrate good sportsmanship!

Designed for entry-level players, this one-day event gives competitors a chance to play singles and doubles in a team-friendly environment that allows substitutions, encourages coaching, and fosters camaraderie. Boys and girls can play together, keeping the atmosphere social and fun.

Traditional tournaments have been a part of Colorado's tennis history for more than 100 years. Players compete against others of similar age and skill development, with opportunities to challenge at the Sectional and National level.

All **Futures** and **Challenger**-level events feature multiple-match, single-day player-friendly formats.

LEVELS OF PLAY

Placing your child at the proper tennis ability level increases their aptitude to develop and grow as a tennis player. The ball color and size of court may vary depending on what your child's age and level is but the key descriptors to determining ability doesn't vary between age levels. This Levels of Play chart can help you determine what level fits your child best. We recommend talking with a coach or facility coordinator if you feel your child is between levels. Or pick the level that the majority of boxes best describe your child.

Gamifying the game

All 7-10 year old divisions in Colorado tournaments and Junior Team Tennis have been "gamified" with added online tracking game-play elements.

In addition to playing right-sized tennis with modified racquets, balls and courts, kids in Colorado track their own points from earning "stars" and "trophies" as they progress through the 10 and Under Youth Tennis Tournament Pathway.

Player's progress is tracked through Sanctioned/"**Tagged**" tournaments and Junior Team Tennis, where players earn participation points/credits (**STARS**). Players earn achievement credits (**TROPHIES**) at select tournaments if they reach the finals, and additional points if they win the tournament.

The mission is to clear each level (**ORANGE** then **GREEN**) by collecting a combination of 20 stars and/or trophies (=1,000 points). Players can track their progress on their unique Player Profile Page. The more they play, and the more they improve their skills, the

more stars and trophies they accumulate. The way the system is designed, every child develops at his or her own rate, therefore there is no specific timeline for moving along the pathway.

Players are eligible to advance to the **GREEN** level (a traditional 78-foot court with a green ball). If they accumulate an additional 1,000 points (or 20 stars/trophies) at the green level, they can advance to the **YELLOW** level.

Players have the choice on whether to advance on points. They can opt to remain at the **ORANGE** or **GREEN** level until they automatically progress out of the system on the first day of their 11th birthday month.

Progress updates will be published weekly, and emails will automatically be generated by the system to alert kids/parents who have advanced to a new ball level. Players will also occasionally receive emails with encouraging status updates.

Introduction to Competition

Colorado offers several opportunities for youth ages 11-18 to compete against other inexperienced players.

- Junior Team Tennis and Colorado sanctioned tournaments have divisions for players in specific age groups (12s, 14s, 16s, 18s).
- The **GREEN ball** is used for all Entry-Level/Futures competition in all age divisions.
- A USTA membership is required for all sanctioned tournaments, but is available for **FREE** for new players.
- JTT and 3v3 Team Tournaments do not require a membership, but players must be registered through NetGeneration.com.



First-time junior players PLAY FOR FREE

Any junior player (age 18 & under) interested in competing in their first Futures tournament can receive a USTA annual membership for **FREE**.

Compete as a Team

New for 2019, nine (9) entry-level tournaments will use the 3v3 format, in which two teams (comprised of boys, girls and/or co-ed) will compete against each other in side-by-side singles and doubles action. Players can substitute in and out between games.

Coaching is not only allowed, it is encouraged!

The team format is a great way to introduce inexperienced players to competition.

Climbing the Ladder

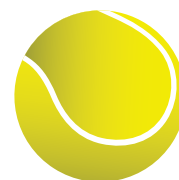
As young players gain experience through Futures events (Team Tournaments and traditional tournaments) and Junior Team Tennis play, they gain confidence to compete at a higher level. Challenger divisions offer juniors the opportunity to experience the next level of competitive play.



Challenger tournaments are geared toward intermediate-level players with some competitive experience — Junior Team Tennis, Futures tournaments, and/or high school doubles. These tournaments can act as a bridge between our Futures events and our Championship level events, or helping high school age competitors gain experience in order to move up their school ladder.



12s Challenger
divisions compete with the **GREEN** ball.



14s-18s Challenger
divisions compete with the **YELLOW** ball.

Tournament players "graduate" from Challenger (and must register in the Championship division) play once:

- s/he has attained a National or Sectional ranking the previous year; or
- s/he has earned 400 or more points in their age division at which they competed at the Championship level.

In **Junior Team Tennis**, USTA Colorado offers two levels of Challenger player (A and B), to help make matches even more compatible.

Players can register in Challenger A (CA) and Challenger B (CB) for both the Summer and Fall seasons of JTT.

ADVANCED COMPETITION CHAMPIONSHIP

LEVEL 5-6

Taking it up a notch

Youth players who have successfully competed at the intermediate level and are ready to take their game up a notch will find new challenges at the Championship level.

In addition to the dozens of Championship tournaments held in Colorado every year, there are also Championship divisions in JTT for youth who want the team experience.



The **YELLOW ball** is used for all age divisions, with a special **GREEN ball** series offered for Championship-level 12 & under players (see page 29).

High School singles players are likely to find compatible competition in Championship events.

The highest levels

Top-level players seeking to compete at the highest level in the Intermountain Section can apply to compete in Level 3s and 4s. These events feature a 64-draw and will be open to the highest-ranking players who apply.

10s TAGGED

All 10s Tagged Events are part of the Youth Progression Series. Players will compete on a 60-foot court with an ORANGE ball until they have completed the ORANGE level and moved to the GREEN level. Indoor events are \$25/player, outdoor events are \$20/player.

NON TAGGED 10s

Non-tagged events will provide an opportunity for those 10 & under players who may not be quite ready for tagged event competition to get some valuable experience in a slightly less competitive environment. Indoor events are \$25/player, outdoor events are \$20/player.

GREEN BALL SERIES

The GREEN Ball Series is comprised of 12s Championships Events which will utilize the GREEN ball instead of the traditional YELLOW ball. See page 29.

3v3 TEAM TOURNAMENT

New for 2019, 3v3 Team Tournaments are events built for entry-level and intermediate competitors. See page 21.

FIND BY EXPERIENCE LEVEL

Each tournament is color-coded:

- Events in **GREEN** are Futures/L8 events.
- Events in **BLUE** are Challenger/L7 events.
- Events in **BLACK** are Championship/L3-6.

There are no assigned levels in the 10s TAGGED division.

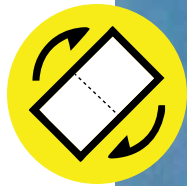
RANKINGS/STANDINGS

All junior sanctioned tournaments in Colorado are assigned a specific level, ranging from 3-8 (3 being the highest). Ranking/Standings points vary depending on the level of the event.

+ EVENTS: formerly known as "DESIGNATED"

Several Championship & Challenger-level events are worth additional Colorado junior ranking points. They are indicated with a **+** after the event name.

For best tournament viewing, rotate Big Book to the right.

When your son or daughter is ready to advance their game, junior tournaments are perfect for kids who want to test their skills, get out on the court and make new friends along the way.

USTA Colorado sanctions entry-level to advanced-competitive tournaments for players of all abilities seeking to take their game to the next level, or just have fun with friends. Futures (entry-level competition) and Challenger (Intermediate)-level tournaments are offered in both traditional competition and the new "TEAM" format. All Futures and Challenger events feature multiple match draws.

Players that have achieved success at the highest level of competition in our state and have met the requirements for Intermountain Sectional Endorsement can be eligible for entry into USTA National-level events.

Verifying Tournament Information online

Players are encouraged to verify all tournament information online. All information in the 2019 Big Book is accurate at the time of publication, but is not complete in terms of all details. You will find draws, times, weather announcements, entry fees, directions etc. on the tournament web page.

Reminder it is the players responsibility to obtain and verify all match times.

All 7-10 year old divisions in Colorado tournaments and Junior Team Tennis will be "gamified" by adding online tracking game-play elements to engage players on the youth tennis progression pathway.

In addition to playing right-sized tennis with modified racquets, balls and courts, kids in Colorado will track their own points from earning "stars" and "trophies" as they progress through the 10 and Under Youth Tennis Tournament Pathway.

CRITERIA FOR ADVANCING THROUGH THE YOUTH PROGRESSION SYSTEM:

Beginning January 1, 2018, a player may elect to move to the next ball color by accumulating a combination of 20 virtual stars and/or trophies by meeting the following criteria:

A. Age Eligibility

A player is not eligible to earn stars and/or trophies until the player reaches the first day of the month of the player's seventh (7th) birthday. A player remains eligible to earn stars and/or trophies until the player reaches the first day of the month of the player's eleventh (11th) birthday. The age restriction for earning stars and/or trophies applies not only to tournaments but also to Junior Team Tennis.

B. Stars earned for participation in section/district-sanctioned 10s Tagged progression tournaments

- Tournaments must be sanctioned and Youth Progression 10s Tagged events in the 2019 schedule
- Sanctioned events will follow all criteria listed in rules and regulations in order for players to receive proper credit.
- Players will earn two (2) stars for each tournament they enter (100 points).
- Stars may be earned by completing a 10U Junior Team Tennis season (Summer and/or Fall).
- Players receive three (3) stars for competing in a JTT season, with up to two (2) JTT seasons per year (maximum total of six (6) stars or 300 points).

C. Trophies earned for results in section/district sanctioned 10s tagged progression tournaments

- Trophies, in addition to stars, may be earned by winning a sanctioned Youth Progression 10s tagged event in the 2019 schedule.

- Sanctioned events will follow all criteria listed in rules and regulations in or for players to receive proper credit.

- Players will also receive a trophy for being a finalist in a sanctioned Youth Progression 10s tagged event in the 2019 schedule.

D. Non-tagged events (NEW in 2019)

- The 4 (four) non-tagged events will provide an opportunity for those 10 & under players who may not be quite ready for tagged event competition to get some valuable experience in a slightly less competitive environment. Players will not receive stars or trophies in non-tagged events.

E. Players may earn stars & trophies only for the ball color in which they competed

- A player will continue to accumulate stars and trophies until he/she is no longer age eligible.
- To get more practice, players can always participate in their previous ball color and level. However, stars and trophies will only be awarded for the new ball color and level.
- When a player earns 20 virtual stars and/or trophies, players will not progress to the next ball color until the USTA updates the youth progression system. Timing of updates is determined by USTA National. (System is updated every Tuesday)
- Players may view the accumulation of stars and/or trophies on their My Tennis Page. Players shall promptly notify USTA Colorado of corrections to their player record on My Tennis Page.
- When a player earns 20 virtual stars and/or trophies and progresses to the next ball color, that player will start at zero (0) credits in the new ball color
- For USTA Junior Team Tennis, players may

earn stars for the ball color and level they are currently in, whether playing orange or green ball 10U JTT.

F. Out-of-Section Youth Progression Tournaments

- Players can receive participation stars for playing outside their home section, provided the event is in the same ball color or level as the player regularly participates in. Players will not be eligible for trophies when playing outside home section.

COLORADO SANCTIONED 10s EVENTS / 2019
