Adult League Incentives

USTA Adult 18 & Over W 2.5 Division & M 3.0 Division	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Any tennis professional or coordinator who forms a “new team” in the W 2.5 division or M 3.0 division for USTA Adult 18 & Over will receive \$200.For teams that do not meet the “new team” requirement, but have new players, the tennis professional/coordinator will receive a \$10 incentive per new player. <u>This is not in combination with the \$200 new team incentive.</u>Any player who did not play USTA Adult 18 & Over League at the W 2.5 level or above in 2022, but plays in 2023 is considered a “new player.”Any player who did not play USTA Adult 18 & Over League at the M 3.0 level or above in 2022, but plays in 2023, is considered a “new player.”A new team is defined as having 50% of its players who did not play at the W 2.5 level or M 3.0 in the USTA Adult 18 & Over League in 2022.USPTA Professionals will have their names entered into a drawing for a trip to the US Open or the USPTA World Conference.
CTA Adult 18 – 39 League	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Receive \$30 for each team that registers through your facility.
