**Executive Director Report,** Shelby Rhyne

1. We have 10 RCTA Summer Interns to help with our NJTL network of seven summer day camps. Anna Luking (RCHS), Ayden and Dylan Smith (WRMS), Kaitlyn Marquardt (RCMS), Neil Chudasma (RHS), Gabrielle (Morehead) and Tristan Hollifield (McMichael), Bryson Chapmon (RHS), Daniel Crowder (RHS) and three Parkview Village teens (RHS).
2. Schools tennis continues to grow with six spring Kids Tennis Clubs and 4 fall KTC reaching over 200 children sponsored by a grant from RC Community Foundation and a 9-session High School PE Tennis class at Morehead HS sponsored by our Xerox Foundation grant for 24 students.
3. Net Generation update: There are 16 Net Generation Community equipment kits in RCS elementary, middle, and after school locations. We have 2 Net Generation Schools partnership agreements signed with Leakesville-Spray Elementary and Morehead HS.
4. Facility Update:
  - Jaycee Park, Reidsville, will resurface 4 courts in June with assistance \$15,000 grant from USTA.
  - Farris Memorial Park, Mayodan, renovation project has been submitted for review to USTA Facilities Assistance. If approved, they will be eligible to apply for USTA grant funding.
  - Eden Parks & Recreation Department, Eden, has plans to resurface the 4 Bridge Street courts in their 2018 budget.
