

The 2023 MPOA Annual Meeting was held on October 4th. The Minutes of the Meeting will be provided 1-2 weeks before the next meeting currently planned for January. Residents may have noticed construction work activity going on south of Shadetree Apartments on Cypress Village Boulevard. An outside development company is building approximately 180 one-story rental homes (800 to 1,300 square feet) with no attached garage. The development will not be a part of the MPOA. We will have no authority, nor will they contribute to Boulevard maintenance.

We will be resuming assessments for 2024. They were paused for the last 2 years.

We also wanted to mention a few reminders for pet owners:

Dog owners are required to restrain their animals with a fence or leash...

Under the Hillsborough County Animal Ordinance. [ARTICLE II. - ANIMAL CONTROL., Sec. 6-19.d)] "In order for a dog or cat to be allowed on a public street, road, park or other public property, excluding public right-of-way on an owner's private property or unless otherwise specifically permitted, the dog or cat shall be under the direct control of the owner or keeper." [Sec. 6-28.] The use of the word "shall" means that this is a mandatory requirement. "Direct control shall mean immediate, continuous physical control of an animal at all times, such as by means of a fence, leash, cord or chain of such strength to restrain the animal."

Dog Owners are required to pick up their dog's feces...

"Any feces deposited by a dog ... on public property, public walks, recreation areas or the private property of others must be immediately removed by the person who has custody or control of the animal unless otherwise authorized by the property owner". [Sec. 6-32. Animal waste removal.]

And, as we begin decorating for upcoming holidays, we wanted to share this community reminder:

Exterior holiday decorations and color lighting may be displayed for Halloween from October 1st through November 1st and for winter holidays from November 1st through January 10th, of each year. At no other time during the year are holiday decorations or color lighting allowed other than the lighting mentioned above.

Members who do not follow these rules will be considered to be in violation of Association's governing documents.
