## INTERNATIONAL AND IMMIGRANT STUDENTS

All international and immigrant students must meet with Athletic Director Jason Barnard in 3-117, the Athletic Office, to review policies and turn in the required documents prior to specified deadline:

- > FHSAA Form EL4
- FHSAA Form GA4 if you are a 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade student
- > Two (2) consecutive semesters of grades from a school in your home country prior to transfer

## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

You are considered an international student if you have entered into the United States from your home country on a visa, and you do not currently have a Residency Card ("Green Card") for the Unites States. In addition to the documents listed above, you should provide:

- Copy of your Visa
- ➤ DS-2019, I-94, or other relevant immigration documents

#### **IMMIGRANT STUDENTS**

You are considered an immigrant student if you have immigrated to the United States by some other means and do not have any proper traveling documents between your home country and the United States. You may have documentation from the Dept. of Homeland Security due to various situations you encountered while immigrating. In addition to the documents listed above you should bring any immigration or Homeland Security documents you may have.
