

UNIVERSITY HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS

HOME SCHOOL, CHARTER SCHOOL AND PRIVATE SCHOOL STUDENTS

If you are a home school, charter school, or private school student and are interested in participating in athletics at University High School, you must have the following items complete and turned in prior to the deadline.

- FHSAA Form EL12 (only for private school students that meet requirements)
- FHSAA Form EL12V (only for private school students that meet requirements)
- FHSAA Forms EL7, EL7V, and EL9 (only needed for home school students)
- FHSAA form GA4 (needed for all non-traditional students)
- Original birth certificate (a copy will be made and the original returned)
- Official transcript from current school including all high school credit courses
- Proof of Residency
 - Two current utility bills addressed to your parent/guardian's home (zoned for University)
 - A driver's license that matches the bills in your parent/guardian's name
 - Lease or mortgage to prove residency for University High School
