

Regis High School Booster Club Work or Pay Guidelines

Your Regis High School Booster Club provides the necessary funds to support Regis athletics and co-curricular activities by admissions, concessions and clothing sales at Regis sporting events. In order for the Booster Club to be successful, parent volunteers are needed to work at least **four (4)** events throughout the year **or pay \$200**.

Parents of all athletes, regardless of sport or season, are required to issue a \$200 check to the Regis High School Booster Club prior to their son/daughter being allowed to attend practice. The check will be cashed only if you opt out of working or fail to work your scheduled shifts. The \$200 check must be turned in at the Code Signing meeting (which occurs an hour before the first practice), along with sports fees, physical forms, etc. **Do not send paperwork or checks to the RCS Central Office.** Athletes will not be allowed to practice until the Work or Pay fee is submitted. This policy will be strictly enforced with no exceptions.

Please note: If your athlete only plays in the spring, you are still obliged to work or pay. Spring schedules offer few of these opportunities so you may want to fulfill your obligation during a fall or winter sport season.

If you select the "Opt Out" option, please contact the RHS Office and you will not be scheduled for any events.

We have an online sign-up for Work or Pay shifts. Please see the sheet enclosed for detailed instructions on this process. The fall sports have been entered and are available for sign up. There are several slots available for each event. You will be able to see who has already signed up for each shift. However, you can only sign up or change scheduled shifts for your family. The following are requirements for shifts:

- An adult must work the scheduled shifts.
- High school students may work with a parent for service hours, but it will not apply toward the family's four required shifts.
- Two parents working one event will receive credit for two shifts worked.
- If you fail to access the website and sign up for four events, we will assign you to work and notify you of your scheduled events.

After you have worked your four shifts, your \$200 check will be destroyed. **If you fail to work the assigned shifts, your \$200 check will be cashed.**

Quite often, Regis athletics teams are involved in playoff games which cannot be accurately scheduled in advance since we do not know dates or times of competition. Emails will be sent as playoff shifts are added to the scheduling program.
