

CONSTITUTION

L-P ATHLETICS BOOSTER CLUB

(proposed changes are in yellow)

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this organization shall be L-P Athletics Booster Club.

ARTICLE II – PURPOSE

The objective of this club shall be to promote interest in athletics and to provide support for the LaSalle-Peru High School athletic teams, and to foster their objectives and assist in their projects.

ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

Any interested booster shall be eligible for active membership. An active Athletic Booster Club Member is one person who attends at least 5 Athletic Booster Club meetings each year and has worked on at least one Booster Club function each year. An active member is not limited to parents, but rather may be any adult interested in L-P sports.

ARTICLE IV – ORGANIZATION

The officers, consisting of the President, Vice-President, or Co-Presidents, Secretary, and Treasurer shall be voted on by a majority vote of all Boosters parents present at the meeting. The nominations shall be presented in the April or May meetings. The term of office shall be one year, beginning July 1st of each year. (June 2012)

ARTICLE V – MEETINGS

The governing body Booster Club members shall schedule one meeting on the second Wednesday of each month, (excluding the months of June, July and December). (June 2012)

ARTICLE VI – COMMITTEES

The standing committees shall be: Constitution and By-Laws, Check Into Cavs (Fund-Raising) , Concessions, Spirit Wear, Yard Signs and Decals, State Qualifiers, Sport Programs and Scholarship. (June 2012) No member having a child eligible for a scholarship shall sit on the scholarship committee. (April 2006)

The committees will be filled with active booster club volunteers. (June 2012)

Ad Hoc committees shall be appointed as the need arises.

ARTICLE VII – EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Executive Board shall meet at a time specified by the President and such other times as the President or a majority of the Executive Board may determine.

The Executive Board shall consist of Elected Officers and the current Athletic Director. The AD will not have voting privileges. The Executive Board shall have all voting rights for the organization. The governing body and executive board shall be one and the same.

The Athletic Director shall serve as the liaison between the Board and all committees and the School.

ARTICLE VIII – PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The rules contained in "Robert Rules of Order" shall govern this club in all cases to which they are applicable.

ARTICLE IX – AMENDMENTS

The Constitution may be amended only at regular meeting after the proposed amendments(s) have been discussed at the last two previous meetings. Changes will be approved by a two-thirds vote of the Executive Board Booster Club members present at the meeting.
