



**Christie Schumacher**

Christie Schumacher is arguably the greatest female basketball player ever to wear a Milford jersey. The old gym was frequently visited by scouts/assistant coaches from schools like Tennessee, North Carolina, Michigan, Michigan State, and Duke. Eventually she accepted a full scholarship to the University of Michigan.

Christie finished her career as Milford's all-time leading scorer with 1,814 points. She also holds the career rebounding record (955). Her season records include most points (644) and highest field goal percentage (52%).

Perhaps the most memorable record, however, came at the expense of the Lakeland Eagles at Milford. Highlighted by a barrage of 3 pointers, turn-around jump shots, and fast break baskets, Christie scored an incredible 55 points to set a new single game record.

Schumacher was selected to the Oakland Press DREAM TEAM and to the Associated Press "All State" team. In addition, she finished second in the Miss Basketball voting. The award is presented annually by the Michigan high school basketball coaches. The fact that she finished so high in the voting for this prestigious award further validates her status as one of Milford's best ever!

A very gifted athlete, she graduated with eight varsity letters in basketball, volleyball, and track & field. .

Christie is currently in graduate school, working on her master's degree in Pharmacy at the University of Michigan. She resides in Ann Arbor.
